The National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health (NIOSH) has reviewed your request dated November 20, 2003. This request was for an extension of approval to add an optional outer liner to the models 2800N95 and 2801N95 N95 filtering facepiece respirators approved under TC-84A-3002 as per drawing #2800N-001, Revision D and drawing #2801N-001, Revision E. This request will allow these respirators to be produced using alternate color schemes.

This request is granted. Approval is granted for English language only on all documentation. It is the manufacturer's responsibility to correctly translate materials desired in languages other than English.

Since this request does not affect the approval labels, final labels are not enclosed.

The approved assemblies consist of the parts as listed on the approval label plus the assembly matrix. Parts are to be marked with the numbers indicated on the approval label in a legible and permanent manner (marking cannot be removed without evidence of its previous presence).

No changes may be made to any respirators and accompanying documentation without prior written approval of NIOSH. Requests for changes must be submitted to NIOSH and a modification of this approval must be granted before changes are made.
